The newly designed interior of St. Joseph's Assisted Living Residence in Lauderdale Lakes was a researched and thoughtful transformation creating space with state of the art focus. The goals to foster homelike settings within long-term care facilities were attained, while still incorporating flexible layout with sufficient space for circulation and mobility. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the elderly population will more than double between now and the year 2050, to 80 million. That means roughly one out of five adults in the U.S. will be over the age of 65. The aging of the population will affect every interior environment—private. commercial and public. One of the biggest challenges in the next 30 years will be how to meet the demand for quality living environments for the burgeoning population of older adults. This will require modifications to much of the existing housing stock, as well as making changes in new construction today that will accommodate older residents' needs in the future. Design is less traditional, and more transitional, trying to make it feel like home, but it's edgier and has cleaner lines than it did 10 to 15 years ago. Color choices can be tricky, considering that seniors have difficulty seeing blues and greens, so design should incorporate contrasting, vibrant, warm colors. Due to budget and practical restraints, communities cannot remodel on a regular basis, so it's important to use colors that have longevity and won't appear dated in a short amount of time.
